






Tower: Clocks being primed and painted. Partial roof torn off and papered in. Four sides of lead coated copper flat lock pans started.

Ogee Domes: SW & NW paint preparation, primed, shingles removed, papered, 2 sides LCC; NE paint preparation shingles removed and papered.





Stone: Cleaning, patching, tuck-pointing and 100% stone consolidation treatment.

Minerva: Restoration completed (paint striped and re-painted); installation pending.



Roof: Shingles removed, papered in, Eco Star with ice dams partially installed.
