CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 3

Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to:

- Ban gifts from paid lobbyists to legislators and their employees;
- Reduce legislative campaign contribution limits;
- Change the redistricting process voters approved in 2018 by: (i) transferring responsibility for drawing state legislative districts from the Nonpartisan State Demographer to Governor-appointed bipartisan commissions; (ii) modifying and reordering the redistricting criteria.

State and local government entities estimate no costs or savings. Individual local governmental entities expect significant decreased revenues of a total unknown amount.
