County Clerk Candidate Filings as of 2:45 p.m. on January 13, 2021

WARRENSBURG, MO -- Johnson County Clerk Diane Thompson began taking filings Tuesday, December 15th at 8 AM for the following offices to be elected at the April 6, 2021 General Municipal Election.

The order in which candidates will appear on the April ballot is determined by the order in which they file except on the first day of filing, the order will be determined by a random drawing. The names of candidates filing on the first day of filing for each office on each ballot shall be listed in ascending order of the numbers drawn, with the lowest number being first on the ballot [that number is designated before the candidate name in “()”]. Candidate filings after the first day of filing will be taken on a first come first served basis. Filing will continue during regular business hours with the last day of filing being Tuesday, January 19th by 5 PM. Proof of identity in the form of a Voter ID card, Missouri Driver’s License, birth certificate, or other form of certified or photo ID will be required for filing.
