### REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL: Johnson County Audit

Johnson County, Missouri invites qualified certified public accountants to submit proposals for the performance of an audit of its financial accounts and records covering the period of January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017, for the purpose of rendering an auditor's opinion regarding the fairness of applicable financial statements and a separate report of the internal control, management weaknesses observed, and county's compliance with applicable legal provisions, in accordance with generally accepted government auditing standards. Also, the County is asking for a separate bid for the single Audit Act Amendments of 1996 and OMB Circular A-133 as this won't apply every year.

It should be noted that Johnson County hopes to establish a working agreement of at least three years with the firm selected. For this reason, we are asking each firm to list the fees for audits of 2017, 2018 and 2019. However, the County reserves the right to accept the proposal on a one year basis.


#### Proposal Submission


