### QUESTIONS

- 1. Is a bid bond not required for this project? A bid bond IS required for this project.
- 2. What is the estimated construction cost? Rough estimate of approximately \$400,000, an estimate of \$422,000 was provided last fall for materials and labor.
- 3. Have you issued any addenda for this project? This one addendum has been issued.

- 6. We do not make an asphalt mix using used tire rubber, that being the case can we simply leave that line item blank without our bid being considered non-responsive? You may check NO on the Used Tire Rubber Product column. Checking NO will not make the bid "non-responsive."
- 7. How many dump trucks would Johnson County be able to provide to haul mix? Johnson County can provide at least eight (8) trucks.
  - a. If there are not enough trucks can we supplement with additional trucks in order to meet our productions? Yes.
  - b. Would the tons our trucks haul then be billed at our hauled/in place number? The tons hauled by your trucks would be billed at the "Price per Ton Delivered by Company" rate as identified on your Bid Form.

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- 8. What is the required contract completion date? Johnson County Commissioners are still in discussion of the best time for the work to be completed.
