Johnson County is seeking applicants for a Full-Time Emergency Management Director position. Applicants must have two or more years' experience working in Emergency Management or Public Administration and possess strong interpersonal communication skills. Applicant must also have (or obtain within 3 months of appointment) certificate of completion from the Department of Homeland Security (SEMA) for required National Incident Management System (NIMS) training. Successful candidates must also possess a valid Missouri Class C Driver's license and the ability to pass the County's background check. Must be skilled in the use of personal 'computers and associated software and hardware.

This position prepares plans and procedures for responding to all-hazards incidents under the general direction of the Johnson County Commission. The Emergency Management Director serves as the principal point of contact by collaborating with cities, public services agencies, civic leaders, business officials, and other interest groups, as well as assisting with the development and sustainment of the Local Emergency Operation Plans (LEOP), Sustainment/Enhancement Grants, Training/Exercise Opportunities, and overall incident/event coordination support.
